**HAS YOUR PROVINCIAL
HEALTH INSURANCE RUN
OUT?**

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If your provincial health insurance has expired (this may happen when your work permit expires—check with your province), you will need to get private health insurance to tide you over until you are once again eligible for provincial coverage (IE when you have a new work permit or PR).

NB: Visitors and those on implied status are (generally) *not covered* by provincial (IE government) health insurance.

Very Important: If you are pregnant and seeking private coverage, please note that insurance is based on each individual's circumstances (number of weeks pregnant, etc.).
