“I am on the IEC Working holiday visa and I’m starting my new job in Canada. Am I a resident for tax purposes even though I am not a Permanent Resident of Canada?”

Guidance from an accountant:

Select YES

“The employee should fill out as resident for tax purposes. The definition of resident for tax and immigration are different, so most of the time people are tax resident, if they are working and living in Canada. Their immigration status for residency will be completely separate.”
